To whom it may concern

Notification of two Real Time Closure in Danish Waters in the Skagerrak.

Please be informed that inspection of two fishing vessels in accordance with Commission Regulation (EC) no 724/2010 of 12 August 2010, has revealed that the amount of juvenile fish in the catches is found to be too high.

Due to this information, it has been decided to close two areas for the period from the 29 of March 2023 to the 18 of April 2023 at midnight.

Straight lines between the following positions limit the two closed areas:

The area is closed for fishery except for the following gears:

- Pelagic trawls, purse seine, driftnets and jiggers targeting herring, mackerel, and horse mackerel
- Pot
- Scallop dredges
- Gillnets
